Giorgos Argeitis is Associate Professor of Macroeconomics at the University of Athens, Greece. He holds a BA in economics from the University of Athens, an MS from the University of London and a Ph.D from the University of Cambridge (UK). He teaches macroeconomics, Post Keynesian economics and international political economy. His research interests are Post Keynesian-Minskian macroeconomic/monetary theory and policy and Old-institutionalist/evolutionary theory. He has published four books about the Greek economy and is the author/co-author of academic papers that have appeared in, for example, the *Journal of Post Keynesian Economics*, *Cambridge Journal of Economics*, *Review of Political Economy*, *Contributions to Political Economy*, the *European Journal of Economics and Economic Policies*.
